

Cormorant Lakes Watershed District

Board of Managers, Mid-Month Meeting

Monday, May 16, 2011

The May 16 mid-month meeting of the Cormorant Lakes Watershed District (CLWD) Board of Managers was held in the Cormorant Town Hall, Cormorant Room, 10929 County Highway #5, Cormorant, MN, with the primary purpose being to review the 2010 A.W. Research fly-over results.

Those present were; managers Jody Beaudine, Orvis Olson and Ellis Peterson; inspectors Duane Erickson and Sheldon Struble; administrator Woody Olson; Advisory Council member Maggie Metcalf; and presenter Alan Cibuzar, president of A.W. Research Laboratories.

A.W. Research Fly-over: The purpose of the flyover is to assess the trophic status (level of phosphorus-loading) in the CLWD lakes, as well as identify possible point sources of new phosphorus input. Alan reviewed aerial photos of each lake in our watershed, pointing out where the trophic status changed in the lakes (such as deeper parts, shoreline parts, and shallow bays). He also noted how the photos can be used to direct our inspection efforts.

Results for the lakes are recorded on CD, available for future reference.

Other business: Jody made a motion, seconded by Orvis, to approve a permit application from Chad Weisgram. Motion carried. Documentation is on file.

Bills Paid: Jody made a motion, seconded by Orvis, to pay the bills presented. Motion carried.
